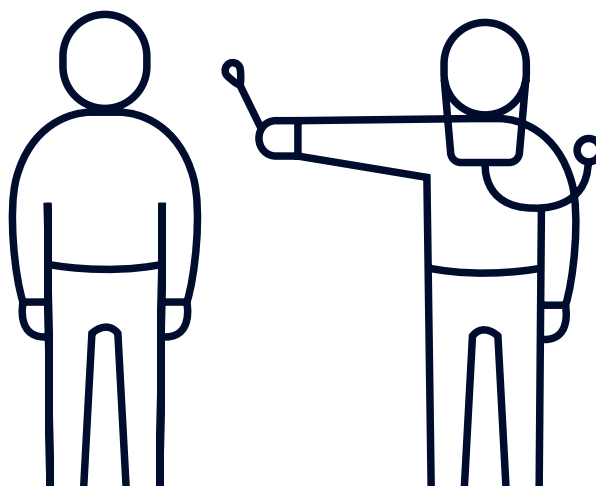


Test for COVID-19



Denmark is one of the countries in the world that tests the most people in relation to population. This is important in order to keep the infection rate down and the epidemic under control.

In Denmark, we test both those with symptoms and those without symptoms.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, difficulty breathing, headache, aching muscles or sore throat.

Stay at home and isolate yourself if you are displaying symptoms

If you feel unwell and are displaying symptoms of COVID-19, do the following:

- Go home and stay home until your test
- Get tested – and remember to wear your face mask
- Go home after your test and stay at home until you receive your test results.

How to book an appointment for a test

Book an appointment for a test at coronaprover.dk in the following situations:

- You feel healthy and do not need to talk to a doctor, but you would like to be tested anyway
- You have mild symptoms of COVID-19, but you do not need to talk to a doctor.

Remember that you must use your NemID when you book an appointment for a test at coronaprover.dk

Call your doctor or 1813 in the following situations:

- You have symptoms of COVID-19 and you feel unwell enough to want to talk to a doctor
- You are worried or unsure
- You want a child under the age of 2 years to be tested.

You should also be tested if you have been in close contact with an infected person. Close contact typically refers to those you live and sleep with, but it can also include colleagues and friends you have been close to.

You should take a test if requested to, in such cases. This may be, for example, in connection with hospitalisation, treatment or examination, or as part of infection tracking in the event of an outbreak, for example in schools, residential areas or workplaces.

How to get your test results

Log in to sundhed.dk with your NemID to see the results of your test.

If you are infected with COVID-19, your result will state 'Positiv', 'Formodet positiv' or 'Påvist'. If you are infected, it is very important that you go into isolation so you do not infect others.

If you are not infected with COVID-19, your result will state 'Negativ' or 'Ikke påvist.'
